## Norman (Norm) F Jay (Nov 25, 1933-June 10,2020)

The first time I met Norm Jay was in 1987 at my second Just For Openers Convention in Chicago. Being a lifelong salesman he had a great personality and that always came out quickly in a conversation with Norm. He was sharing a room with Jim Shoulter and I remember Jim had some nice openers for sale but Norm had mostly general beer advertising items. I mentioned to Norm I had an Atlantic Ale beer glass and he said he was interested. I called it an ice cream bowl type (but it is known as a schooner bowl). I remember asking \$25 and Norm wanted it but he had one question. It would be my first lesson from Norm Jay. He asked, "you didn't find a bunch of these did you?" I told him no and realized in my 10 years of collecting I had never thought to ask that question when buying something. It has proven useful over the years and Norm did buy the glass.

We met again at the 1991 ABA Convention at the Oldenburg Brewery. My mother was with me and got the full treatment of salesman stories from Norm. Over a 50+ year career of selling there was 8-10 years he had a salary and or some expenses paid but most of the time it was straight commission. He was on the road a lot and whenever he was home for a few days he would know when it was time to get back on the road as Judy would have his suitcase packed and sitting in the hallway. My mom understood as my father was a salesman most of his life but most of his 29-year career with P. Lorillard he only traveled locally and was home every night. Norm told many interesting travel stories.

Our next encounter was at the 1992 JFO Convention at the Oldenburg Brewery in Fort Mitchell, Ky. Norm was rooming with another JFO veteran collector, Bill McKenzie from Colorado. At the time I really wanted a K-4 Pabst Tapster and Norm had one available. It took two days (Norm always had to sleep on a deal for at least one night) and in the end I traded 18 "A"s and "B"s for the Tapster and Norm added a B-18-502 Capital with the Tapster. There were a lot of nice openers going to Wheaton and in later years I would always remind Norm that it was the worst trade I ever made. It was eclipsed by some corkscrew trades later on but I was still learning and obviously had a lot more to learn.

We next met at the ECBA Convention in 1994 in Philadelphia. I visited with Judy and him most of the show and really got to know him well. The next year they came to JFO in St Joseph, Mo. and by then Judy had retired and would be attending

the beer shows with him. We discussed the Jays hosting the JFO Convention the following year and in 1996 they hosted the first of two Conventions in Lisle, Il with a second one in 2000. They did an outstanding job running both conventions. Both times Pat and I arrived early and Norm and I would spend a couple of days working on “big trades”. He would always tell me that I was the only collector he would trade openers out of his collection with. Over the years we consummated many trades and almost always high quality openers.

The mid-1990s I was attending most of the National Beer Club Conventions and would spend a lot of fun times with Norm and Judy. I quickly learned another Norm saying, “some large breweries did not put out much advertisement and some small breweries put out a lot stuff.” Norm was a veteran collector who always tried to treat everyone right and always dealt fairly.

Over the next 25 years we met up at shows and I visited Judy and him many times at their home in Wheaton, Il. Norm’s openers were displayed in his basement and I usually started there first but he was always picking up a nice piece of advertisement. We started a trade down in his basement but the deal would be completed in his den (or the “mug room” as I called it). Trading produced another of Norm’s famous sayings, “when two sides leave a trade thinking they both made a bad deal, it was a great trade.”

Close to 20 years ago we were in his basement trying to complete a deal when Dave Lendy dropped in. I learned another one of Norm pet peeves. When he was trading he wanted it one on one and no one else watching and chiming in. He asked Dave to stay upstairs until we had completed the trade. He softened on this stance over the years because at shows we would deal in his room most times and he always had customers.

The past 10 years trading became much tougher as Norm had reached the point of not wanting to trade many openers in his collections such as Illinois, L-2 bottle corkscrews, painted openers and “C”s among the categories that were keepers. I had gotten many of the openers I wanted from his other categories so it usually a straight sale situation. He did in 2015 sell me all of his “K” barmounts, B-18s and B-21s as he needed display space. Most of the sell deals were on a much smaller scale but not many cheap openers involved. We always had some little deal going on. I will miss our haggling times greatly and just the general conversations. We thought a lot alike.

Dave Lendy and I at shows would help (mainly Dave) Norm load and unload his merchandise. He knew exactly how to pack his car and bring a lot stuff. In 1995 at ECBA Judy drop a few beer mugs and several broke. I never told Norm but every time I helped I would think about her little accident. One of the fun things I

would do at the NABA convention was tracking down a hotel cart for Norm. Anyone who has been to a NABA Convention finds out that a hotel cart is a rare commodity especially Saturday morning before the public show. I was almost always successful.

One of the bonds we shared was Norm and his son Fred were Eagle Scouts and it made him happy to know I was an Eagle Scout also. Early on I had a tendency to tell Norm, "to tell you the truth." Norm hated it and would say, "John when you say that it means you were lying before." Not good for a former Eagle scout. Even if Norm was not available sometimes I always enjoyed talking with Judy and it always included family news to catch up on. They had three great children, Martha, Fred and Amy. Amy will end up with most of his breweriana collection and it is very impressive.

Another couple of things you learned about Norm is one he wore his glasses half way down his nose and used them mainly for close up viewing. You knew things were serious when he would take them off and a big-time Norm observation would be coming your way. Sometimes it would be good for you and sometimes it would not. The second thing was many times we would talk about selling off-grade items. Norm summed it up well as he said I never like trying to sell anything I have to do a lot of explaining or apologizing for. So the rule of thumb is don't buy off-grade openers, corkscrews or anything.

Norm had called in early April and said he was ready to sell the openers since Judy and Amy were not that attached to the openers. I threw out a ballpark figure (\$15K) to buy or I could sell with a 20% commission rate and added he would do better going the 20% way. A week later he called and said let's do the commission rate and when could I pick them up. After a discussion with Pat and the Coronavirus taking off I told Judy I would leave the next Wednesday, get to Wheaton on Thursday, pick up the openers and then head home.

Everyone agreed and I left Durham Wednesday morning, April 15<sup>th</sup>. I made Indianapolis that night and was one of about a dozen guests at a five story Hilton Garden Inn. Traveling was fairly easy as half of the traffic was trucks and hardly any law enforcement was seen. One issue I had not thought about was more people speeding. Chicago would prove to be a race track. I arrived at the Jay's house at 10:30 the next morning. The original plan would be for me stay near Wheaton that night and head home Friday. Pat called and said Chicago would be getting 4-6 inches of snow that night so she wanted me to get the openers and head back to Indy that night.

After 30 minutes of talking with Norm and Judy (Norm looked fairly good but was very unsteady walking), I headed downstairs. Norm made it down and sat on the steps as he told me what I could and could not get. Almost all of the openers were to be sold but his daughter, Amy, wanted to keep some "beer smalls." He watched for two hours as I started with the bottle corkscrews, knives and painted openers. He had a large

board of mainly "A"s and I had most of those down when I took a lunch break. Bless Judy's heart she has cooked some shrimp. Just what I needed.

Norm made it clear I had to take everything opener wise which included some "I" can openers and about 500 E-14s with most being the common ones. By 4:30 I had everything in boxes and was ready to load up the car. There were about ten boxes (big and small) and Norm sold me a rotating peg board display and one glass top showcase. It took about 20 minutes to bring everything up from the basement and load into the car. I had to chuckle as Norm tried to get me to go in his garage and get his stock of show openers. I told him I would catch them next trip. We had a good 45 minutes of conversation before I said a final good-bye and left. Norm would always say, "looking forward to our next conversation." And I think after this trip we had four phone calls before he passed.

The return trip back to Indianapolis was problem free and I was up early the next morning. The trip back to Durham was a quick nine hours and I was home by 6:30. Most of the time I thought about the many good times Norm and I had together. I know it was tough for him to see his opener collection go out the door. The next four weeks were spent sorting, cleaning and cataloging his collection. Many of the better openers have found new homes. Many thanks to all who have who have added openers and cork-screws to their collections..


Don Bull writes:






Norm's opener displays at one end of his basement before I started loading them up. A very impressive collection and worth much more than my offer of \$15K.




His "E-14"s (above) were in the HVAC system room. Impressive collection of brass (right), L-2 Bottles (above) and knives (above right).



We welcome your interest in this new product line and due to the slow manufacturing method and no wholesale sales (direct to consumer sales only), we will never make a bunch of these.

They say the O-2 was made prior to WWII.



**Don Bull wrote Erickson Displays in 1981 and got the above response. Old time employees remembered the O-2 style being made by their company before WWII. They did not remember making the O-6. When the Asian fakes started hitting the market about 8-9 years ago they were not marked "Erickson Des Moines". I assumed at first someone had found the Erickson Archives as many new O-2 and O-6 wall mounts started appearing in the marketplace. Once you own one you realize they are porcelain and newly made. After the first few O-6s were made, most of the subsequent O-6s have "Erickson Des Moines". The Asian fantasy/reproduction wall mounts should have left the Erickson Des Moines name off. One day hopefully we will know who really made the O-6 painted wall mount.**



## Final Trip to Art Santen's House

Art's family had decided it was time to clear his house out and get it ready to be sold. After communicating a few times with Steve Santen, it was decided I would come out March 13th and spend a couple of days going through the openers left in the house. Art had over 40,000 at one time and maybe 10,000-15,000 had been sold. I wanted to get his Budweiser newer openers as he had many types that I would need for the revised Handbook Picture guide.

I left Durham on Friday the 13th and made it to Paducah, Ky the first night. The next day I arrived at Art's house around lunch time and surveyed the thousand of openers left. Thankfully Steve had been working for several days and was bringing up all of the openers in the basement. Between the sloping stairs and sheer number in the basement it took a big effort to move them all. I sat down at a small card table and proceeded to check every opener in every box. Steve had boxed a bunch and had done a nice job of removing and boxing many that had been on Art's display boards.

To load things up I brought 20 large plastic boxes with lids. I worked until supper time and headed to the hotel and went for a nice steak dinner that night. I came back and worked until 10PM and filled up six of my large boxes the first day. I was checking out openers and Steve kept bringing stuff up from the basement. At one point Steve's sister, Susan, showed up to help. They were hoping I would take most of them and did end up bringing 20 boxes of opener, corkscrews and bottle cappers. Most everything was newer openers.

Art had started selling some of his openers in 2010 and everything in 2018. After four previous visits by Tommy Campnell and myself along with numerous local collectors and dealers most of the good stuff was long gone. It was still a lot of fun looking and it was amazing to me that Art must have never passed an opener without buying it. At least it seemed that way. Sunday I started at 8AM and by 4:30PM had checked out everything and ready to call it quits.

Late Monday morning I came back and loaded a few more things including a metal wine rack Art had. The Expedition was packed to the ceiling and it was time to head home. At least the openers were all on the main floor and even with my 20 boxes I took, probably 60 boxes remained. Thank you Steve for helping so much. He did finally clean the house out and sell it this summer.

I was on the road by 11AM and next stop was Bob Sudduth in Belleville and we had a nice visit and Bob did buy an A-B knife I had. Bob has the finest known U. S. beer knife collection in the country. I was able to see in person his recent acquisition of a N-54-3 A-B knife. Mind blowing that something like that would be unknown until this year.

From Bob's I headed to Jim Osborn's house in Herrin, Il. I arrived mid-afternoon and had the privilege of seeing another awesome collection in person. Jim collects mainly types and had many great pre-pro openers. He also collects Lithographed openers and bottled shaped openers. A sideline are pre-pro beer glasses. It was a great two hour visit and we managed to work a trade out and Mary Jo fed me a nice supper before I got back on the road.

For a backdrop this was the weekend most states were shutting down due to Covid-19. I was going to stay near Jim that night but decided to head onto Nashville to spend the night. It worked out well except my

room that night faced the interstate and I heard traffic all night. I was up early the next morning and arrived back in Durham by 4PM. Pat was so happy I had brought so many openers back. She was really glad there would be no more of Art's openers. With five trips to his house to buy openers I have boxes everywhere in the house. I tell her it is just inventory. Thank you to the Santen family, Bob Sudduth and Jim and Mary Jo Osborn for making it an outstanding trip.




**“Opener and eBay Trivia” (Gary Deachman’s M-1s & M-2s with a Bottle/Man)**
